A Series of Midweek Worship Services for the Season of Lent

The prophet Amos compared the voice of God's judgment to the roaring of a lion (Amos 1:2). The Lord roared and Amos preached. This Lent, we will listen to the Lion as he rumbles and gathering under the cross, we will all the more be amazed when the roaring Lion defeats His greatest enemies: the devil, hell, and the power of death. Then, with resurrection joy we will say of Jesus, "The Lion of the tribe of Judah – has conquered" (Revelation 5:5).

Ash Wednesday, March 6 + Rescued from the Rubble • Amos 1:1-2

The world, the devil, and our old Adam tempt us to clip the claws on the Lion and clean up His bloody Passion. But the Bride of Christ is called to holy reverence before the LORD, the King of the universe.

Wednesday, March 13 + Upside Down • Amos 3:1-8

God does not leave us only with the prophet Amos. Jesus is Israel's greatest prophet, and He speaks to us pardon and peace through His suffering and dying on the cross.

Wednesday, March 20 + This is the Night the Lord has Made • Amos 5:18

Our only refuge from the day of darkness is to trust in Christ, our Redeemer, who is our Light and our Salvation.

Wednesday, March 27 + Grieving for Joseph • Amos 6:6

Scripture offers only one source of confidence: "O LORD of hosts, blessed is the one who trusts in You" (Psalm 84:12).



Wednesday, April 3 + Locust Here, Locusts There, Locusts Everywhere • Amos 7:1-6

Amos's first two visions (7:1–6) announce the certitude of divine judgment; they also emphasize the prophet's compassion for "little" Jacob, who is "so small" (7:2, 5).

Wednesday, April 10 + Lion Alert! • Amos 7:10-17

By the power of God's Word and Sacraments, we are empowered to speak up against injustice, trusting our Savior, Jesus, to give us courage and confidence.
