**Palm Sunday, April 14 + Raise Your Palms and Your Praises!**

Jesus enters Jerusalem. Through God's Word we process with Him to the Cross where we witness His passion and His love – for us!



**Maundy Thursday, April 18 + The Taste Test • Amos 8:11-14 + (Services Begin at 12:10 & 7 p.m.)**

**Good Friday, April 19 + Buried! • Amos 9:1-6 + (Services Begin at 12:10 & 7 p.m.)**

**Easter Sunday, April 21 + Come to the Feast! • Amos 9:11-15**
